ADMISSIONS

Co-ordination of Admissions to UG & PG courses at PIMS Medical College – 2024-25

As per directive of CENTAC (Centralized Admission Committee) Govt. of Puducherry, the Admissions to UG/PG courses at PIMS were completed.

- a) **PG (MD/MS)** A total no of 2708 applications were received by the CENTAC office, of whom 54 PG students were admitted to the various courses at PIMS through counselling, relevant records has been submitted to CENTAC office and National Medical Council of India, New Delhi.
- b) **MBBS Admissions:** CENTAC had received 5893 applications, as per the directive of the permanent Admission committee (Govt. of Puducherry) the procedure of admission through CENTAC for admission to the I MBBS (2024) course was followed. Through the process of counselling, admission was given to 75 Management students, 18 NRI Students, 57 State Govt. Quota students, and their relevant records submitted to Pondicherry University and the CENTAC / Admissions Committee (Govt. of Puducherry).
- c) **M.Ch Plastic Surgery-** The Medical Counselling centre, (MCC, MOHFW) did not allot any candidate for (2024-25) admission to PIMS, hence the seat lapsed.

Submission of PG (MD/MS/MCh) Dissertations:

- The dissertations of 50 postgraduate students (MD/MS/ MCh 2021 batch) were submitted to Pondicherry University in the academic year 2024-2025.

Pondicherry University Examinations:

- The pass percentage of postgraduate students who appeared in the Pondicherry University examination held in August 2024 was 100% (2 out of 2 postgraduate students).
- The pass percentage of postgraduate students who appeared in the Pondicherry University examination held in January 2025 was 97.7% (43 out of 44 postgraduate students). Fourteen departments achieved a 100% pass rate, which are as follows:

OUT REACH ACTIVITIES

1. P.I.M.S. has helped **CHAD, a country in North Central Africa**, to set up their first Histopathology laboratory in Ndjamena, the capital of CHAD. CHAD has an MOU with Madras Medical Mission to help the health services. In September of 2024, one Pathologist(Dr. Renu G'Boy Varghese), one Microbiologist(Dr. Sheela Devi) and one histopathology lab technician(Ms. Rekha) went to Ndjamena, the capital of CHAD to help them in setting their first Histopathology laboratory and in sensitizing the doctors and nurses in Hospital Infection Control practices. Ms. Rekha stayed back in CHAD to train and work at the laboratory. For two months, the Histopathology Lab here under Dr. Moses supported the reporting of their cases.

Dr. Indira, Histopathologist from P.I.M.S., worked there for 3 months till they could find their own Pathologist. In addition to this, 3 technicians from CHAD are being trained in histopathology techniques to take over from Ms. Rekha when they return from India. P.I.M.S. has lived up to its motto of reaching the unreachable. We thank the Management for their unstinting support for this whole project.
