THE BEGINNING

The Pondicherry Institute of Medical Sciences is the outcome of the vision of the Madras Medical Mission to create a medical school offering innovative medical education with international participation. The aim is to produce health professionals with a commitment not only to provide high quality medical care but also do research to prevent and alleviate disease processes. The hospital and college are set up in serene environment of greenery on the East Coast Road near seacoast, 12 miles north of Pondicherry town, the land of Auroville and Aurobindo Ashram enriched with French traditions. The then Honorable Home Minister of India Sri L .K. Advani laid the foundation of the hospital and college building on 12th July 2000. The Emergency Block was inaugurated on March 8, 2001 by the then Chief Minister of Pondicherry Thiru.P.Shanmugam and the hospital units started functioning from October 2001. All specialty departments of the hospital started functioning from January 2002.

DEVELOPMENT

In the first phase a hospital and college was developed within a span of two years to provide health care, community outreach programmes and medical education. The college and hospital spread across 45 acres of land close to the Bay of Bengal, has separate buildings constructed for Basic Sciences, outpatients and inpatients. The hostels for students are in the same campus which also has recreational facilities.

In the next stage of its growth, the hospital expanded to provide specialized treatment facilities in all super specialties and established a college of Nursing.

At present, the institution also offers postgraduate programmes in all disciplines with emphasis on education, research and treatment with international inputs to give the best care to the people from India and abroad. The hospital at present has 740 beds and is to be expanded to 1000 beds in the coming years.

EDUCATION AT PIMS

Our institute has undergraduate and post graduate medical and nursing students with a vision of training them in all aspects of life. The students are encouraged to participate in sports, cultural, religious and academic activities both intramurally and extramurally with strong emphasis on ethics. Our faculty are from across India and help in nurturing our students to become competent medical professionals to contribute to the health needs of the community and provide holistic service to the community. A mentorship program is also in place to support the students.

PIMS is a home away from home for all those who study and work here.

COMMUNITY HEALTH PROGRAMMES

Consistent with our motto to reach the unreached, PIMS has established various Community Health Outreach centers; Lawspet Urban Health centre, Rural Health Centre, Anichakkuppam and the Chunampet Rural Health Centre. As our social responsibility, we are also aiding the government in running their Primary Health Centres at Muthialpet, Kalapet & Alankuppam (Sub centre).

Helmet

1. It is mandatory for all undergraduate students who use two-wheeler / four-wheeler in the premises of PIMS to comply with the following

HOSTEL STAY

All MBBS Students including 1st Year MBBS Students should compulsorily stay in PIMS Undergraduate hostels except for Pondicherry localities and students who stay with their parents.

RAGGING:

1. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the hostel. Perpetrators will be dealt with suitable disciplinary actions.

DAY-SCHOLAR AND OUTSIDERS:

2. Parents, relatives, siblings, days scholars etc are not permitted to stay overnight in the hostels.

P.I.M.S FACILITY FOR STAY

3. Parents may avail International Guest House,

BANNED ACTIVITIES AND GROUP ACTIVITIES:

4. Possession or use of alcohol, addictive drugs, narcotics and tobacco products is strictly prohibited within the hostel. Students found in possession of or using any of these, or found to be under the influence of these substances will be asked to vacate the hostel immediately and suitable disciplinary action will be initiated against the individual. The security guards in the hostel have the authority to check the incoming baggage of students for the purpose of detecting contraband items being taken into the hostel.

VALUABLES:

5. Each student shall be responsible for her/his belongings. The college is not responsible for any theft or loss of valuables. Reporting of theft if any, must be made immediately in writing to the warden.

HOSTEL ROOMS AND COMMON AREAS:

6. Each student shall be responsible for keeping her/ his room clean and tidy.
7. Furniture and fitting provided in the rooms/ common rooms/ mess / bathrooms etc., should not be damaged or removed. Loss or damage will have to be financially compensated by the persons responsible for it.

8. Students are required to switch off room lights and fans, bathroom lights, AC, exhaust fans and geysers when not in use, especially during the daytime.

MESS:

9. In view of students health and safety, it is made mandatory for all students staying in the hostel to consume food from the hostel mess only
10. Students are not permitted to carry mess food or mess crockery / cutlery to their rooms.

HOSTEL TIMINGS AND 'OUT-PASSES':

11. No one will be permitted to remain in the hostel during class hours, unless certified by the PIMS. "Staff Student Health Clinic" to be sick and unfit for attending classes.
12. Each inmate must adhere to hostel timings as fixed by the authorities. All resident students must be inside the hostel by 9.30pm.(except first year students for whom the IN time is 8.30pm)
13. Students must sign IN and sign OUT after classes by 4.30 pm on weekdays, 1.30 pm –on Saturday and all times on Sunday /public holidays with details as required in the Register maintained by the security at the door.
14. No one should leave the campus without the Warden's permission
15. While going home, 'OUT PASS' has to be obtained from the Warden. 'OUT PASS' may be availed on any two evenings per week.
16. No 'Out- Passes' will be issued
 - During institutional activities such as College Annual sports week, AURA, EQUINOX, Graduation day and students council handing over ceremony etc.,
 - Between 8.00am and 4.00pm on week days, and between 8.00am and 1pm on Saturdays, except those days specified in the institutional Holiday list.

DECORUM AND MORAL VALUES:

17. An atmosphere conducive to study should be maintained. Loud music and watching television/videos with loud volume is not permitted.

VEHICLE:

1. Adequate vehicles and transportation facilities are available from PIMS to town and back.
2. Students are not permitted to possess any vehicle (two/four-wheelers) inside the campus and if found will be fined appropriately.

3. In the event of any mishaps/accidents the parents are solely responsible for their wards.

Zenith

Zenith is a good place to grab a quick bite in case you woke up late and missed the hostel mess breakfast. Both dine-in and take-away are available here. They accept cash, cards and Google pay.

Zenith has another on campus air-conditioned restaurant near the library which serves both Indian as well as Continental food. Even though the food there is a tad bit pricier, it's worth the extra buck as it is very hygienic and tasty. They only have dine-in option and do not deliver to the hostel.

Nescafé

This little stall near the OPD is frequented by almost all PIMSonians for refreshments. You can get yummy snacks (like Masala Maggi and Sandwiches) and your daily dose of caffeine and juices to get you through the day.

Café de Flore

The newest edition to PIMS dining is situated near the guest house. They have a number of freshly baked treats to satisfy all your food-cravings. The impressive display of mouth-watering snacks is really the icing on the cake. They accept cash, card and Google pay.

La Pause

This is THE place for that cup of coffee as well as Horlicks, Boost or any other refreshment you need while studying for your exams, open almost 24x7.

De Cellar

This bustling canteen in the center of the OPD building is off-limits to the freshers(it's a PIMS tradition). So we'll let you discover it by yourself, when you reach second year.

Around Campus

PIMS has a few places, within walking distance, around the campus that offer pretty decent food. Those of you with sensitive stomachs, we suggest that you tread with caution.

Just Cakes - This is the place to go to in case you crave sugar and also the place to go to order a cake if you want to celebrate your friend's birthday. They offer both delivery and dine-in. They accept Cash, Card, Paytm and Google Pay.

Ordering-In

Food delivery such as Swiggy and Zomato has been available since the year 2019. For people with unpredictable cravings, you can choose to order food from restaurants in and around Pondicherry.

MISCELLANEOUS

In and around campus, you can get groceries at AkkaKadai located near Zenith and Café De Flore also stocks basic amenities that you would require. You can also check out Sarathy's grocery store located just outside campus. In case you aren't able to find what you need, check out the various shops like Nilgiris, Vijayaganapathy stores etc. in town. There is also an online grocery store- Lemart.in which allows you to order groceries from fresh produce to stationary with a minimal delivery fee directly to campus.

Amazon, Flipkart, Myntra, Nykaa, etc all deliver directly to our campus and usually wait near the MRI Gate for deliveries.

Xerox shop- Located near OPD, it provides services for Xerox, spiral binding and phone recharges. The library also offers printing services.

Bank and ATM- We have a bank located in a building near the main gate. PIMS has two ATMs- one next to the bank and one next to the Xerox shop (right outside the OPD).

Laundry- There are laundry services available at request who can iron and wash your clothes. Our hostel has a regular laundry system available that you can enquire about with the hostel secretary. There is one laundry service available right outside the hostel situated inside the campus and another laundry right outside the hostel main gate.

STUDENT ACTIVITIES:

Students' body elects a Student Council every year to look after student activities. Students of all batches are further divided into four houses namely Fortius, Altius, Citius, and Ulterius, depending on various factors/talents, as decided by the House Captains (Girls & Boys).
